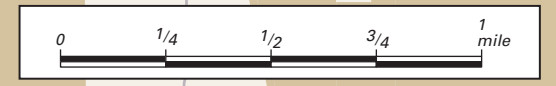


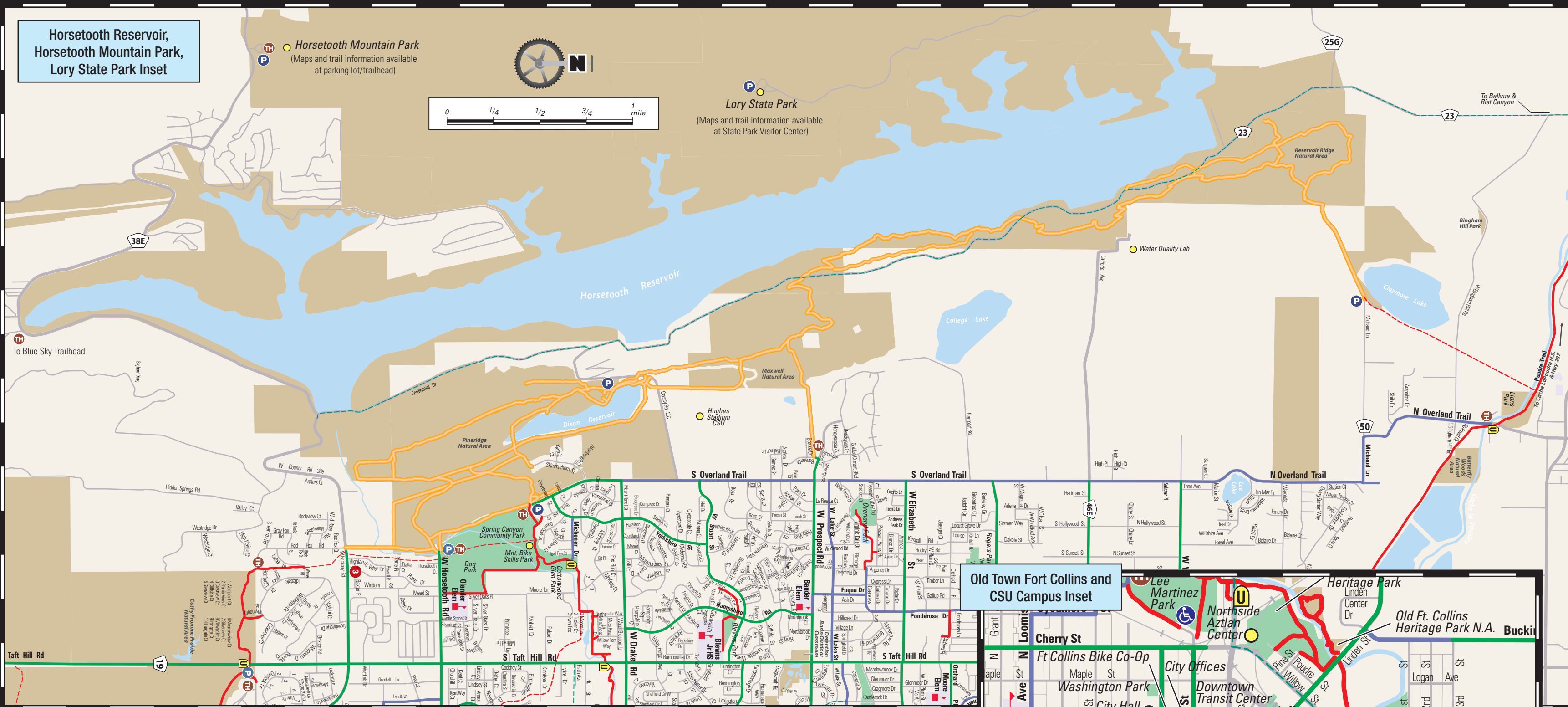
FORT COLLINS BIKEWAY SYSTEM LEGEND

 - Designated Bike Route with bike lanes



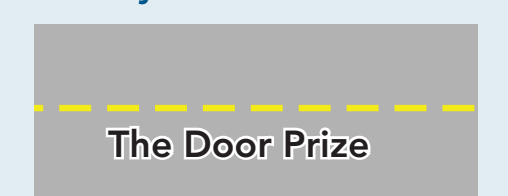
Every Season is Bicycle Season

- Tips and Resources for Bicyclists
- FC Bike Library** Begins Spring 2008. Check out how to borrow a bike for yourself and visitors. www.fcbikelibrary.org
- Emergency Locator System.** These signs are located every quarter mile along the trail and have an alpha numeric code which represents the distance you are from College Ave. (i.e. PE3 indicates "P"oudre Trail, "3" quarter mile units, "E"ast of College Ave.)
- Always wear a helmet when riding a bicycle!**
- Bike at night with lights!** State law requires bicyclists be equipped with a headlight and rear light at night.
- Be careful** of low angle sun during fall and spring as motorists may not be able to see you.
- Biking on College Ave.** north of Laurel St. and south of Harmony Rd. is legal.

- Ride Respectfully**
 - Bicycles are traffic, follow the rules of the road.
 - Stop at stop signs and traffic lights when cars are present in the intersection.
 - Make eye contact with motorists when turning or crossing intersections
 - Do not ride the wrong way in a bike lane or on a one way street.

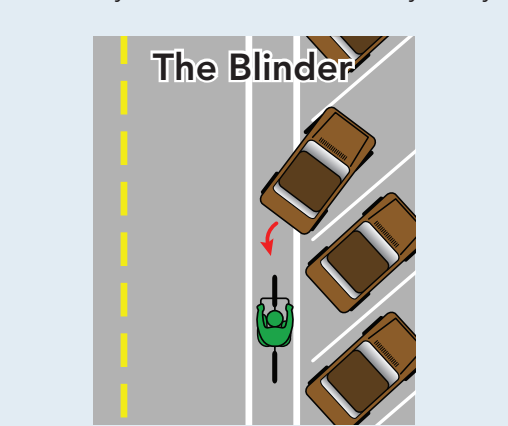

Common bike accidents and ways to avoid them:



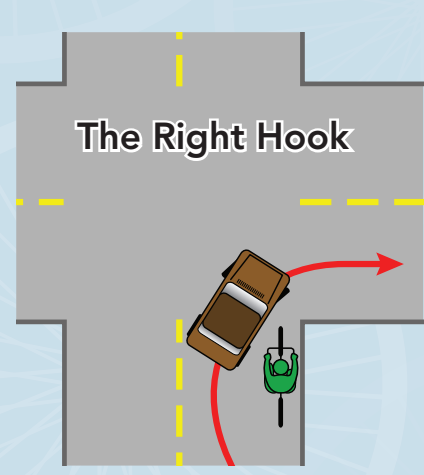
How to avoid this collision:
1. Ride to the left. Ride far enough to the left that you won't run into any door that's opened unexpectedly. You may be wary about riding so far into the lane that cars can't pass you easily, but you're MUCH more likely to get doored by a parked car if you ride too close to it than you are to get hit from behind by a car which can clearly see you.



How to avoid this collision:
1. Ride to the left, and be cognizant of the white reverse lights.

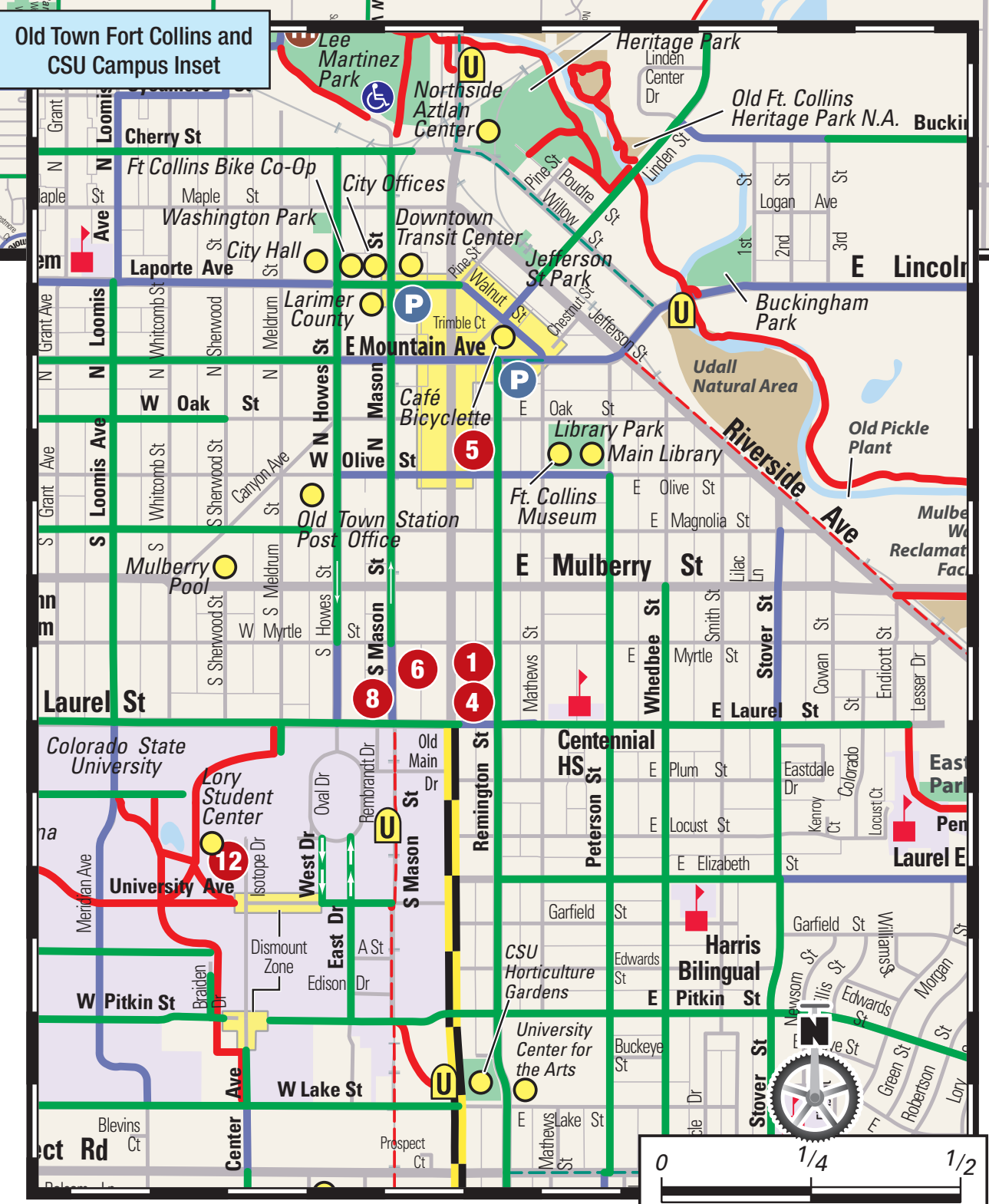


How to avoid this collision:
1. Don't ride on the sidewalk. When you come off the sidewalk to cross the street, you're invisible to turning motorists.
2. Get a headlight. If you're riding at night, you should absolutely use a front headlight.
