Part 26, as amended, the City of Fort Collins, Colorado hereby notifies the public that it is recommending the following Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for applicable professional services, construction and procurement contracts during Federal Fiscal Years 2024, 2025, and 2026. This goal will begin October 1, 2023 and end September 30, 2026. The overall goal for each Fiscal Year is 2.29%, with 2% being a race-neutral goal and 0.29% being a race-conscious goal.
