- 1. Send to buildingdocs@fcgov.com. (please send one e-mail per address with all documents)
- 2. Send only PDF files, named properly for public record (link) (different naming than at submittal).
- 3. Only send documents that are relevant to a project (i.e. if no elevator, then no elevator special inspection).
- 4. Only send passing documents, please check prior to sending. (Failed inspections/tests will be rejected).
- 5. Please budget **48 hours** on business days for our team to review your documents.
 - a. *Notice:* Final docs are reviewed and processed in the order received from all customers. We do not prioritize, rush or expedite based on house closings or grand opening events so please plan accordingly.
