

Stone Circles at Bobcat Ridge Natural Area

Stone circles are a physical representation for Native American cultures and often centered around their ceremonies. They represent many systems within one circle including the sacred cycle of life (birth, death and rebirth), the four cardinal directions (north, south, east, west), and the elements (air, water, earth, fire). Stone circles also serve as a representation of the connections between Mother Earth, Father Sky, and an individual. "There are at least three additional stone circles within 3 miles of Bobcat Ridge, some containing multiple rings".
