Round 1: April - May Key Dates **Application Opens:** February 1 **Submit Application:** Discuss ideas with your neighbors and decide what project to do! **Applications Due:** February 28 **Award Decisions Made:** Early March Time for the Fun -Host your event or project! **Wrap Up & Submit Receipts** within 2 weeks of event or project completion

Round 2: June - August

6	Wrap Up & Submit Receipts within 2 weeks of event or project completion
