NEW DATES: Remington Street Construction

The City of Fort Collins Streets Department is scheduled to complete asphalt paving on Remington Street from Mountain Avenue to Olive Street as part of the 2013 Street Maintenance Program. Closures will be required to complete the work and construction will begin September 23. The project is expected to last approximately three days, however, weather has a large influence on the schedule and construction may be delayed because of precipitation. The parking garage on Remington Street will be open to the public; however, the entrance on Remington Street will be closed, please use the Mountain Avenue entrance. Closure information and a map of the impacted area are located on the back of this sheet.

• September 23-25: Remington Street CLOSED, Mountain Avenue to Olive Street

Project dates are estimates based on favorable conditions; variances may occur due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

Parking

Parking will be restricted in the work zone and all vehicles will need to be moved to an available parking area (side street) prior to 7:00 a.m. <u>Please read the "No Parking" signs carefully to identify the exact date and times when your street/block will be affected by the operation.</u> The placement of these signs shall take place at least 24 hours prior to the commencement of work. The towing procedure will begin at 7:00 a.m. for all cars that remain parked on Remington.
